Rule of the Month

OAC 5101: 2-7-03 (A)

A foster caregiver shall work cooperatively with agency representatives as a member of a care and treatment team responsible for planning, providing and discussing the care and services provided to a foster child and shall fully disclose all information related to a foster child's problems or progress to agency representatives.

Trauma-Informed Discipline:
What Caregivers Need to Know—
This workshop deals with methods to use challenging behaviors as an assessment and engagement tool with children and teens.

Saturday, February 8th (9am-4pm) **Dynamics of Adoption–**

This workshop will heighten the awareness of the dynamics that newly adoptive parents experience when adding a child to their family.

understanding the caregiver's
overall style of parenting and
approach to children & how
changing the caregiver's approach

Tuesday, February 18th (5:30-8:30pm) Managing Infertility Grief and Loss as a Foster and Adoptive Parent—This workshop will increase foster and adoptive parent awareness of the impact infertility issues have on the caregiving family, and strategies to manage these issues.


Keeping Kids Safe will be audited sometime this summer. We ask that any of the following be turned in if a change has occurred:
